Thefts of Catalytic Converters in Shepperton and Charlton Villages

New style Mercedes vans continue to be the favourite target for the theft of the catalytic converters (CAT) and there continues to be a crime problem in the Shepperton and Charlton areas particularly, with parked-up vans being targeted overnight. Peugeot 806 and Peugeot 406 vehicles are also being targeted.

Retainagroup Ltd are manufacturers of a product that protects a CAT from theft. Surrey Police are using these kits to mark the CAT visibly and permanently with a unique code and the 24/7 phone number of the International Security Register - on which the code and details of the owner and vehicle are recorded.

Registration Plate Thefts Continue...

To make it more difficult to steal registration plates from vehicles, Surrey Police have been handing out free anti-tamper screw packs. I have also made sure these packs are available from the Police Station at Staines and also Shepperton library. They are going very quickly, so pick yours up before they all go!

Unfortunately there have been instances when even with these screws the number plates are being stolen. I can only suggest that you make sure you are using the right size screws and also glue the plates firmly on.

Possible Council Tax Scam

Message from Spelthorne Borough Council
Please can you get a message out that there may be some fraudsters targeting Spelthorne residents claiming to be from the British Council and asking for bank account details to claim back Council Tax.

Spelthorne Council Tax office would not ring taxpayers to ask for bank account details over the phone and if residents receive such a call, they should ignore it and if the caller is persistent, they should contact the Police for advice.

We have had a call today from a Staines lady who has received at least 10 calls from this alleged organisation and has given them her bank account details and now is checking with us as she was a bit worried.

We have advised her to contact the Police but feel we should get a message out on the web to alert other residents
